a.	At least one year of postdoctoral supervised experience is required. This experience must be in line with the individual's program of doctoral study and consistent with the Statement of Intent to Practice. The postdoctoral experience must be full-time (40 hours per week) for at least one calendar year (50 weeks), or a total of 2000 hours of appropriate experience, or equivalent, within a period not to exceed four (4) years. A part-time post-doctoral supervised experience must be pre-approved by the Board. b.	The supervisee must receive and accumulate a minimum of one (1) hour per week of regularly scheduled formal face-to-face supervision with the specific intent of dealing with services rendered directly by the supervisee.	<input type="checkbox"/> Yes <input type="checkbox"/> No

Because the professional practice of psychology is not limited to clinical work, components of practice other than direct ameliorative services may be included in the postdoctoral supervised experience.
